

Statement by Mr. Frank Davis, Deputy Permanent Representative Permanent Mission of The Bahamas to the United Nations Office and Other International Organizations in Geneva at the 39th Session of the Universal Periodic Review Working Group *Presentation of National Report by the Government of Ireland* Wednesday, 10 November 2021

- (i) Continues to take steps to incorporate the International Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Racial Discrimination into the domestic legal order;
- (ii) Implements the 2019 Climate Action Plan, and advance on the Climate Change Adaptation Framework, particularly how marginalized groups will be protected

and;

(iii) Continues to ensure that human rights and environmental protection are considered in its trade and investment strategy.
